Àlvar Suñol opens the exhibition "Interiors" in Torroella de Montgrí

The Museum of the Mediterranean welcomes, until July 20, this exhibition by the resident painter in the Empordà

The Museu de la Mediterrània de Torroella de Montgrí, opened yesterday the exhibition Interiors by Àlvar Suñol. This exhibition offers the possibility to enjoy a selection of the paintings that this international artist, currently resident in the Empordà, has made in recent years, between 2004 and 2015. In this way, Interiors shows intimate scenes, narrated with a deep poetic content and in very suggestive atmospheres, that speak of the feminine presence, of the own condition of the painter or of the history of the same art. The exhibition can be enjoyed until July 20th.

Suñol presents the paintings of a new stage where there are no sudden changes, but a kind of regeneration, a natural evolution towards the way of seeing and relating things.

Changes that arise, as has happened in other stages of their artistic career, as a reflection of the need to express plastically the evolution and maturation of their ideas and their personal universe, although, on this occasion, with a poetic vision closer to its reality, to its surroundings. In their majority they are a series of paintings of great format with scenes that are developed in

surroundings of domestic interiors. In all of them there is a very personal way of looking at things. The topics covered are like a sequence of images that are lived and remembered, expressed in a narrative discourse that is framed in real or imagined interiors and spaces, where the painter places and exteriorises his world.

They are intimate scenes narrating with a deep poetic content and very suggestive atmospheres, which speak of the feminine presence, of the same condition as the painter or the nature of the history of art.
